Exp. Rigging, Forklift, Overhead Cranes, Survivor Training. • Construct repair parts if commercially available or not available for company central inventory stores. • Plans setup and operates typical machine shop machine tools, producing parts to tolerances and company specifications. • Utilizes typical machinist's hand tools. • Sets up and tests production equipment under power, testing for mechanical difficulties, tracing the sources of the issue and correcting the problem. • Instructed and teach Machinist Helper. • Perform other duties as assigned.
